At the May meeting of the PCC, (4th May 2011), we were pleased to elect John Sams as Deputy Church Warden to the vacancy unfilled at the APCM.

At meetings we receive and discuss reports from the working groups and respond to any proposals. This time we endorsed a proposal from the Worship group to change the seating layout for Sunday mornings using slightly different formats – so do let us know if there is one you like. We also agreed a further period of experimentation with café / messy church worship on 5 Sunday mornings between May and November.

The Mission group is continuing to look at communication – through a new web site, facebook, u-tube and Parish leaflets. They are also planning a number of activities including a beach BBQ for Families week and a barn dance for Harvest.

The Service group make recommendations for mission giving. They felt it was misleading that mission giving appears under a number of different headings in the PCC accounts. It was suggested that if all giving was collected together in one 'pot' it would be less confusing.

The Service group has been discussing prayer – 40 days of prayer, prayer breakfasts, prayer in the community and prayer ministry at all Sunday morning services. A report on the responses to the 40 days of prayer and subsequent reflection will be available soon. The PCC needs to take notice and it will inform our future work.
